problem of poverty ought to pay attention to the nexus between inequality and growth in the theoretical part of this paper arguments that support and challenge kuznets hypothesis are analysed thereafter an interesting proposition developed by addison and corniais presented that suggests that there may be an efficient level of inequality from these different arguments conclusions are drawn and policy implications presented the theoretical part does not attempt to analyse the causes of inequality to identify the causes of inequality it would be necessary to undertake a case by case analysis the general assumption for the theoretical part is that inequality is caused by unequal access to resources as well as inadequate economic policies which can lead to persistent unemployment and poverty unequal access may be caused by market failures especially in the capital and labour markets or by historical and political developments that create uneven power
