abstract this publication is intended to provide guidance concerning diabetes nutrition care the guide emphasizes the need to individualize diabetic meal planning and expands the description of meal planning to include alternatives to the exchange system the exchange system however is the model diabetic diet and receives special attention in this publication objectives and activities to be used when teaching the use of the exchange lists for meal planning are outlined the complete nutrient composition data base that was used to develop the 1986 exchange lists is included

this introductory level text explores both the basics of nutrition for healthy people and nutrition in the clinical setting describes how nutrition supports health including how to select foods and plan meals to meet the energy and nutrient needs of healthy adults and their families also discusses the impact that specific diseases and disorders have on nutrition status and how diet therapy can promote recovery

emphasized in this book are practical considerations of nutritional care in the context of the nursing profession and nursing diagnosis it includes coverage of nutrition at each phase of the life cycle written by specialists in their clinical fields sections on nursing assessment and diagnosis and important developments in the field the impact of drgs peer evaluation in clinical practice nursing diagnosis taxonomy home tpn and new drug diet interactions this new edition features six separate chapters on nutrients such as carbohydrates vitamins and water and electrolytes it provides review questions and case studies for each chapter

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
